Your privacy on the Komosion website

The primary purpose of Accenture's website is to be a dynamic resource and business tool to help you learn more about Komosion, its people and services. We want you to feel secure when visiting our website and are committed to maintaining your privacy when doing so.

What information do we gather?

Komosion collects information at its websites in two ways: (1) directly (for example, when you provide information to sign up for a newsletter; and (2) indirectly (for example, through our website's technology).

We may collect and process the following information:

- Information that you provide by filling in forms on our website. This includes registering to use the website, subscribing to services, newsletters and alerts, requesting a white paper or further information. Pages that collect this type of information may provide further information as to why your data is needed and how it will be used. It is completely up to you whether you want to provide it.
- If you contact us, we may keep a record of that correspondence.
- We may ask you to complete surveys that we use for research purposes, although you do not have to respond to them.
- Any postings, comments or other content that you upload or post to the Komosion website.
- Our website collects information about your computer, including (where available) your IP address, operating system and browser type, for system administration, to filter traffic, to look up user domains and to report on statistics.
- Details of your visits to our website, the pages you view and resources you access or download, including but not limited to, traffic data, location data, weblogs and other communication data. When this information relates to or identifies you, we will treat it as "personal data."

How do we use information that we collect from the site?

We use personal data to provide you with information you request and for other purposes which we would describe to you at the point where it is collected or which will be obvious to you. For example:

- To fulfill your requests for newsletters, offers, white papers or other content.
- For surveys or research questionnaires.
- To personalise your experience at our website.
- To contact you for marketing purposes where you have agreed to this.

We analyze your IP and browser information to determine what is most effective about our website, to help us identify ways to improve it and make it more effective.
